

MCA Youth Paid Intern Overview

Job Description

The Youth Discipleship Intern is a one year (with the option of being renewed) paid, part-time internship that focuses specifically on building relationships and discipling female youth at Mission Creek Alliance Church. The intern will need to love students, have a natural ability to build relationships and be intentional about discipleship.

Responsibilities

Primary: (40 Hours/Mo)

- 1. Mentor female teenagers
 - a. Primarily focus on 4-5 teens (of which, some of the students will hopefully be Rooted leaders). Meet at least monthly with each (15 Hours/mo)
- 2. Build relationships with the youth and their friends (8 Hours/mo)
- 3. Be a small group leader at MCA Youth (12 Hours/mo)
- 4. Attend the pre-teen program (Rooted) once a month to build relationships with the students and leaders (2 Hours/mo)
- 5. Personal Development
 - a. Meet bi-weekly with the supervisor for ministry training. (2 Hours/Mo)
 - b. Complete required readings. (1 Hour/Mo)

Secondary: (8 Hours/Mo)

- 1. Administration Work (For Student Ministries) (4 Hours/Mo)
 - a. Keep student contacts updated
 - b. Send out weekly communications to students/parents
 - c. Track volunteer documents
- 2. Social media updates (For Student Ministries) (2 Hours/Mo)
- 3. Attend monthly staff meeting (2 Hours/Mo)

Qualifications:

- 1. Committed Christian.
- 2. Experience as a leader in a youth or camp setting.
- 3. Experience walking alongside younger Christians.
- 4. An understanding of basic Biblical knowledge & the Gospel.
- 5. Experience being mentored.
- 6. Able to use basic spreadsheets & email punctually.
- 7. Valid driver's license
