Read 1 Peter 1:13-16 & 2:9-12

- 1. What connections can you make between what you learned about Samson and what you read in these passages from First Peter?
- What does 1 Peter 2:11 say about being holy? How does living as a "foreigner" relate to being holy?
- 3. What does Peter seems to be saying in 1 Peter 2:12? How does this relate to being a "holy nation"?

Deepen Holiness is partly about being set-apart. How should Christians be "setapart" from our culture?

How can a holy life be a beautiful winsome force that compels people to consider Jesus?

How have you walked the balance between being set-apart but still involved in the lives of your non-christian friends and neighbours?

Live

God makes us holy in the areas that we surrender to him. What area is God promoting you to surrender? How will you pursue holiness in this area tomorrow?

This question may stretch you as a group. But as you take the risk to be vulnerable, trust that God will bless you. Take time to pray for one another.
