Do you have a COVID-19 safety policy?

YES! We are constantly changing the way we do things to adhere to the current public health orders and limit the spread of COVID-19. After reading the current BC Health guidelines and recommendations, with advice from the Alliance denomination district office, we will be implementing the appropriate safety and sanitation procedures to protect everyone participating in our camp.

Does my child have to wear a mask?

Masks and face coverings are mandatory in public places for anyone over the age of 5. We are committed to providing a safe and positive environment for everyone so for this reason masks will be worn.

What is the age of camp?

- LIT is for students entering grades 5 – 12 in Fall 2022.
- Summer Day Camp is for children who are 4 by the end of 2022 through to those entering grade 4. We will not be able to accommodate older or younger children at this time.

What will my child(ren) need to participate?

Water bottle, running shoes, and a mask (we will have extras if needed!).

Can my child(ren) be grouped with friends?

YES! Please enter any potential group mates when you register. We will do our best to meet as many requests as possible. Note that groups will be organized according to age and that we may be unable to make changes on the morning of registration.

How will groups be determined?

Groups will be determined by age. The age groupings may shift as we see how full our camp gets.

What activities will they be doing at camp?

Crafts, games, science experiments, Bible stories, snacks and so much more. If the weather is nice, we will take advantage and move many of our activities outside.
