3. What do you think about the return of Christ and how does, or could it, affect your daily life?
4. Judgement is based on our actions and choices, not on God's. How do you react to this statement?
5. What about our view of God and his judgement has changed for you because of this learning? How does considering God's judgement as "restorative justice" help or hinder you?
6. Consider the ways you judge others. Compare that with how God views and will judge you. What might need to shift or change?
7. Talk about the flourishing and floundering pattern. What can we learn from it?
8. Why do we need a judge?
9. If we truly believe in God's manifest presence, how will that affect my daily life?
10. How do we choose life, according to Deuteronomy 30:15-20?
