Getting Resurrection Luke 24:36-42

1. **The sermon says the disciples were startled and frightened when they realized Jesus was physically alive.**

What emotions do you experience when you seriously consider the resurrection as a real, physical event rather than just a spiritual idea?

2. **The resurrection was described as an embodied reality, not just a comforting idea.**

In what ways have you tended to treat the resurrection more like an inspiring concept than a life-changing reality?

3. **The sermon emphasized that Jesus' resurrection gives concrete assurance, not just vague hope.**

Where in your life right now do you most need that kind of concrete assurance from God?

4. **We heard that the resurrection means our future is physical and restored.**

How does the promise of a renewed body and restored life shape the way you think about aging, illness, loss, or suffering?

5. **The resurrection shows that this world matters to God and will be healed.**

What is one practical way you can live this week that reflects care for God's world or compassion for others?

6. **The sermon taught that resurrection life begins now when we unite our lives with Christ.**

What part of your "old life" might God be calling you to surrender so that something new can grow?

7. **We were reminded that one of the greatest evidences of the resurrection is a changed life.**

Where have you seen evidence of resurrection power—either in your own life or in someone else's story?
